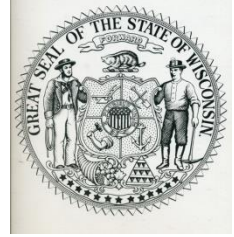

- 50 yd 20 Pigeon board
- 50 yd 10 Hanging 4" tiles
- 50 yd 10 Hanging clays
- 50 yd 10 Hanging cups
- 50 yd* 6 MoSkeets

Team Musket (5 min. events)

- 50 yd 20 Pigeon board
- 50 yd 10 Hanging 4" tiles
- 50 yd 10 Hanging clays
- 50 yd 10 Hanging cups
- 50 yd* 6 MoSkeets

Team Smoothbore (3 min. events)

- 25 yd 9 Pigeon board
- 25 yd 6 Hanging 4" tiles
- 25 yd 6 Hanging Clays
- 50 yd 5 Hanging jugs

Team Revolver (90 sec. events)

- 15 yd 9 Pigeon board
- 15 yd 6 4" tiles
- 25yd 6 Jugs

* Simulated 100 yd even

All ACWSA and N-SSA rules apply, as applicable.

Team Awards

First through third for team Revolver, Smoothbore, Carbine and Rifle(d) Musket.

Fees:

Teams: \$10 per gun per team event.

Directions:

See “bristolranges.com” for directions to the range.

Notes:

Uniforms must be worn for all team shooting events unless weather dictates otherwise.

Revolvers may be shot using one or two hands.

Revolvers must be capped on the line only.

All times are hrs. (subject to change with minimal notice).

Timers must inform the team of how much time is remaining during an event, but only if asked to do so. Stay safe and shoot well.

Commanders: Please have your teams ready when called to the line. Individuals forgetting ramrods, caps, ammo, still cleaning guns etc. are disrespectful to everybody standing on the line waiting for them! Timers must report team time (in seconds) and targets remaining to the desk as soon as practicable. In team events, after the Safety checks each individual gun he clears his team (unless there is a fouled musket etc) all at one time by saying “the line is cleared”. For the sake of time, please appoint your safeties and timers before each event.
