## Invite you to The 17th Annual Frank V Matuszek Memorial Skirmish

Greetings: We invite you, our fellow N-SSA and ACWSA Skirmishers to participate in the 17<sup>th</sup> Annual Matuszek Memorial Skirmish that will be held at the Sandy Ford Sportsman's Club. We are hoping that you are available to come out and participate in our fun schedule of events.

Due to Covid -19 we will be following the May 4, 2021 IDPH Restore Illinois Guidelines. Remember any participating members should stay home if they are sick or symptomatic with Covid - 19. You will see changes around the skirmish due to these Guidelines.

**Very Important Information:** The bridge over the river just West of the Range entrance is under construction and impassable. You must approach the range from the East. In addition to this, there are road signs blocking the road prior to reaching the entrance. It is passable for cars. We will adjust the signs more for the weekend. If you are pulling a trailer or driving a larger RV you may have to move the signs to get in. Please return them back the best you can.

We also will be modifying our shooting schedule so to avoid shooting team events under the hottest times of the day. We will be starting on Saturday with 2 hours of individuals and then switch over to team events. Once team events are done, we will reopen the range for individuals.

Finally Sandy Ford has been working on improving the backstops. They hope to be completed by time of our skirmish. If not, parking down at the range will be tighter. We ask that if possible, please car pool down to the range.

#### **Camping and Lodging**

Camping is available around the club house area as before. Please allow at least 6 feet space between camper or tents. Camping will be allowed starting noon of Friday, June 25<sup>th</sup>. The Club house will be open for <u>bathroom use only</u>. We are also looking into renting little blue houses to improve social distancing. Motels are available in Streator, Ottawa, and Morris. Grocery stores are present in Ottawa and Streator. Most of you have already been to Sandy Ford and know how to get there. If you need a map, please check out the Western Region Web page for a detailed map.

#### Food.

Following the Restore Illinois we are unable to use the Club House for dine-in food service. We will not be offering any breakfast in the club house on Saturday or Sunday. We will be offering a free lunch down at the range on Saturday as well as bottled and canned beverages. We will be offering, free of charge, Pulled BBQ chicken sandwiches with sides for each skirmisher on Saturday night but outside. If guidelines change prior to the skirmish date and we change anything of importance, we will let you know.

This year we will attempt a Carbine II or Repeater demonstration match. This will consist of three person teams and we will firing at three events. All three events will be at 50 yards. Cost is \$10 per person. So if you have a repeater or single shot, bring it out and we will find you a team. Target amounts will determine based on the make of the firearms on the teams.
